HOUSING OFFERS - PARTNERSHIPS WITH SORBONNE UNIVERSITY

The International Researchers' Welcome Desk offers accommodation solutions thanks to partnerships with public and private housing companies.

CITE INTERNATIONALE UNIVERSITAIRE DE PARIS (CIUP)



: 27 boulevard Jourdan, 14ème arrondissement, Paris

2: 50 min on foot - 35 : 20 min by bike

: 25 min by public transport. Subway line 7 at Jussieu (direction → Mairie d'Issy) to Porte d'Italie and then the tramway 3a (direction → pont Garigliano) to the **Cité** universitaire.

Open to: Master's Degree exchange students, PhD students at the Faculty of Science and Engineering

Through an agreement, the International Researchers' Welcome Desk has a contingent of accommodations primarily booked for **incoming exchange Master students**. However, when we have available studios, we can host PhD students.

We have an annual partnership from September 1st to June 30th.

We can therefore only guarantee housing during this period, every academic year.

There are three different kinds of housing: standard and comfort rooms, and studio. The standard room and confort room have shared kitchens, the studio has its own private kitchen. Comfort rooms provide private bathrooms while standard rooms, besides a sink, provide shared sanitary facilities (shared and mixed bathrooms and toilets).

Room Kitchen Bathroom

Every studio provides a small kitchen (with a glass-ceramic two-ring induction hob, a refrigerator and a microwave oven) and a private bathroom including a shower and toilets. The studio also provides plenty of storage space (shelves, cupboards, mirror wardrobe, luggage carrier), a table, an electrical blind and Wi-Fi connexion.

The **Maison des Etudiants de la Francophonie** has common spaces: working room, playroom, communal kitchen, and foyer bar. It also provides other services such as an access to a laundromat and a lockable bicycle room.

All of our rooms and studios are individual, suitable for one person. If you wish to find an accommodation with your partner, please contact the CIUP directly in order to find out about double bedrooms availability in other residences.

The CIUP also provides a housing offer specifically designed for researchers; same for double bedrooms please contact the CIUP directly.

Warning!

We have an annual partnership from September 1st to June 30th.

For an extension of your stay in summer, please contact the CIUP directly.

The maximum duration of stay at the CIUP is **24 months for researchers**.

THE CARMES RESIDENCE

: 10 min on foot from the entrance of the Campus Pierre et Marie Curie

Public: researchers, post-docs

The International Researcher's Welcome Desk holds a partnership of **4 studios** at the Carmes Residence. Every accommodation includes a kitchen and a bathroom.

Rent price 2021/2022: Thanks to our partnership, you can benefit from a special price of 680 € per month.

Warning!

Payment of the rent must be made by bank check only.

Please note the payment cannot be made by credit card / bank transfer / cash.

Please write your check for the "Agent Comptable de Sorbonne Université".

The rent payment is expected before the 15th of each month at the International Researchers' Welcome Desk, Tour Zamansky, 1er étage – Bureau 101, 4 place Jussieu 75005 Paris.

Additional information:

- The 11.5m² studette includes a single bed, a desk, a kitchenette, a bathroom (shower, sink and toilet), and a Wi-Fi connection
- You can move into your room at the Carmes Residence at any time of the day (there is a box for key handover) except on the eve of a week-end or a public holiday
- Each room is cleaned every week
- The residence provides linen, towels, toilet paper and the kitchen towels
- There is no laundry at the residence, but there is a laundromat 2 minutes away on foot

1. The Récollets Residence

2 : 150-154 rue du Faubourg Saint-Martin, 10ème arrondissement, Paris

: 25 min with public transport. Metro ligne 7 à Jussieu (direction → la Courneuve) to Gare de l'Est

Public: researchers, post-docs

The residence has apartments going from 25 m² up to 125 m². Monthly rents are going from 959 to 2 404 €. Each apartment provides sanitary facilities and a kitchen.

Warning! It is not possible to arrive outside of the opening hours, neither on the weekend nor on public holidays.

The residence can only welcome you on weekdays, according to these schedules:

Monday – Tuesday – Thursday from 9.30 am to 1 pm / 2 pm to 6.45 pm Wednesday – Friday from 9 am to 1 pm / 2 pm to 4.45 pm.

Family stays are only possible in the apartments from 50 m² for 3 persons, 60 m² for 4.

They are limited to a couple with two children. The residence does not allow any pets.

2. The Louis Pasteur Villa

(2) : 3 rue des Ursulines, 5ème arrondissement, Paris

18 min on foot from the entrance of the Campus Pierre et Marie Curie

🖶 : 13 min with public transport. Bus 89 from Jussieu towards Gare de Vanves until the station **Panthéon**

Public: researchers, post-docs

The residence has 32 apartments: studios (1) from 21 m² to 25 m², studios (2) from 27 m² to 36 m² and two-bedroom apartments from 25 m² to 34 m². The apartments are all furnished and all have an open-plan kitchen and a bathroom. The villa also offers hotel-like services (free high-speed internet, cleaning, linen and towels).

3. The Cordeliers Residence



i 7 rue de l'École de Médecine, 6ème arrondissement, Paris

16 min on foot from the entrance of the Campus Pierre et Marie Curie

: 5 min with public transportation. Métro line 10 direction \rightarrow Boulogne to the station **Cluny la Sorbonne**.

Public: researchers, post-docs

The Cordeliers residence is located within the University Paris Descartes, now known as University of Paris.

The residence has 18 furnished apartments offering cleaning service, high-speed internet, a fully equipped kitchen, sanitary facilities and supplies. Water, heating and electricity charges are also included.

Warning!

The booking is at least for a month.

STUDAPART

RENTING A SINGLE APARTMENT FROM A LOCAL TENANT

We advise you to take your time to gather information about the housing market in Paris: the process to visit an apartment (including how to prepare your renting application file), the criteria requested to get a lease (security deposit...) and the French renting legal system.

Particulier à particulier

This is the most popular and used website dedicated to the search for accommodation in Paris. The property owners directly display their offers without the help of a real estate agency. Warning: You have to be aware that the housing offers are available for a very short time (sometimes for only two days) and you have to beware for frauds (you should never pay a deposit before signing the lease!). www.pap.fr

Seloger.com

It is the second most popular website. You will find accommodation offers in Paris and in the Paris area. Warning: You have to be aware that the housing offers are available for a very short time (sometimes for only two days) and you have to beware for frauds (you should never pay a deposit before signing the lease!). www.seloger.com

Studyrama

Public: PhD students. Website providing housing offers (individual or apartment sharing) and allowing you to pinpoint every residence thanks to a detailed map of Paris and its region. The rents go from 600 to 1000 € per month. https://logement.studyrama.com/

Warning!

- If you find an accommodation through a real estate agency, please keep in mind that you will have to pay fees (usually about 1 month of rent).
- Some agencies could be called "list merchants". It is a fraud! They give you access to their offers every day for a set period of time (often 4 months) in exchange for very expensive application fees (between 150 and 450 €). Most of the time, those offers are neither enough numerous nor of good quality to get you to actually find an accommodation. You will have payed these application fees for nothing!
